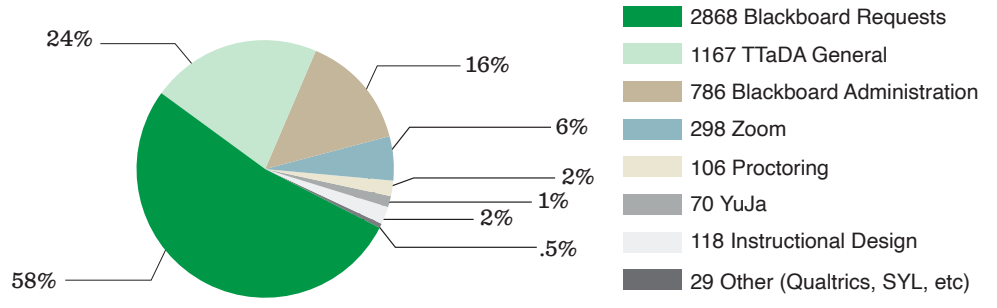


TEACHING TRANSFORMATION AND DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY

2022: A YEAR DEDICATED TO GROWTH AND NEW OPPORTUNITIES

TTaDA provides system administration and support for UND's academic technologies including: Blackboard, Zoom, YuJa, VoiceThread, Qualtrics, and more. Our team handled **4940 tickets**.



Instructional Designers had over **400 consultations** through one-on-one meetings, department workshops, Zoom/Teams sessions, and phone calls. Additionally, the Instructional Design team:

- created **7 interactive guides** for faculty, staff and students in Articulate
- helped build **5 Blackboard courses** for the Online Counseling Masters Program
- completed **2 SAMHSA Grant Funded courses** in HealthKnowledge (Moodle)
- developed **15 virtual lab activities** in Articulate for College of Engineering and Mines
- reviewed over **100 Blackboard Sites** for quality course design including term based, SPEA, and non-credit courses

Offered **235 Workshops**, 17 of which were new, to **1,858** faculty, staff and graduate students on Academic Technologies; Mental Health; Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion; Accessibility; Productivity Tools; and more.

85 unique recording sessions in the Digital Media Studio for a total of 163 hours of recorded video. This was a **37% increase** in the number of recording sessions from 2021.

Demonstrated our commitment to creating accessible and more inclusive digital learning content by participating as part of the North Dakota University System in the **3rd Annual Blackboard Ally Fix Your Content Day** in conjunction with Global Accessibility Awareness Day (GAAD).

NDUS finished 45th overall out of 173 institutions participating with 398 content fixes.



50 faculty took part in TTaDA mentoring programs. Faculty representing all the colleges participated in the Alice T. Clark Mentoring Program (**34 faculty** in the first year and **10 faculty** in the second year). **Six faculty** participated in the Clinical Instructors Mentoring Program.



42 staff members participated in the Staff Mentorship Program. There were **12 staff** in the Spring and **30 staff** in the Fall.

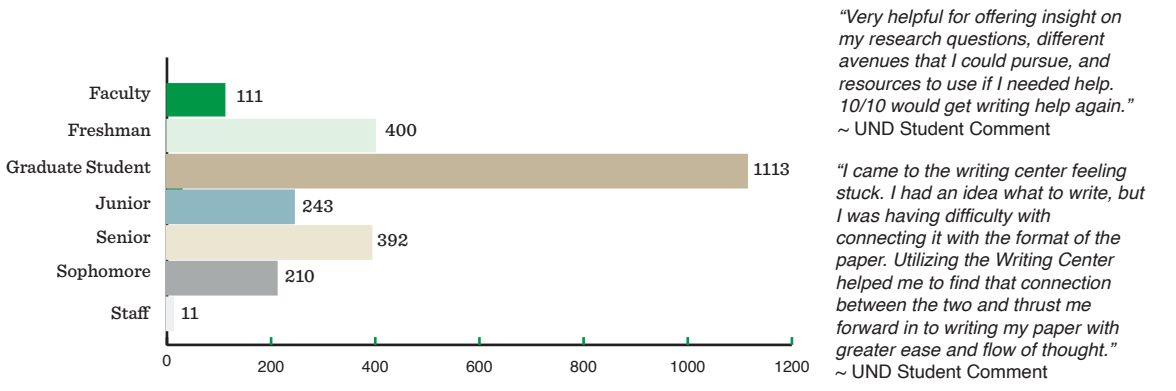


17 new videos were created for Staff Career and Professional Development on a variety of topics. Videos were viewed **2,356 times** for a total watch time of **316 hours**.

TTaDA sponsored **3 special events** with a total of **377 participants**.

The Writing Center had **2341 appointments**, **965 clients** from **100 programs**.



39 Small Group Instructional Diagnosis (SGID) sessions were conducted (22 in Spring and 17 in Fall) throughout 2022. Trained faculty facilitators provided this midterm student feedback in face-to-face, distance, and hyflex courses.

126 Self-Paced Enroll Anytime (SPEA) courses were available in 2022. There were over 4,000 registrations, generating more than **\$4.5 million** in revenue.

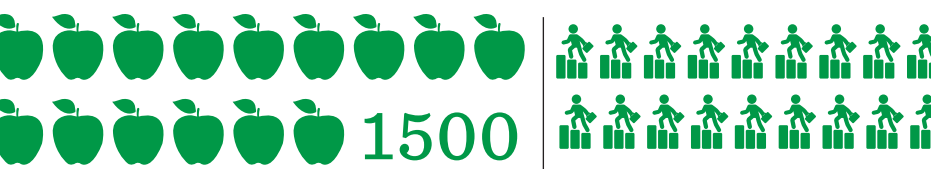
108 enrollments in the 90 hour Pre-Licensure Real Estate Courses. Additionally, there were **76 enrollments** in the Continuing Education courses.



9 Conferences were coordinated by Conferences and Events - **3 virtual**, **3 hybrid**, and **3 in person**. There were 2,021 attendees in person and 640 online. There were 27 UND events managed with 1649 registrations.

5200 enrollments in our Professional Development for Educators program.

- Partnerships with **10 educational vendors**
- **25 school districts** provided district-specific professional development for their educators
- Over **300 online courses** to provide professional growth to educators



1500 annual enrollments in the Dietary Managers Program.

- **50+ Continuing Education courses** available
- Our students make up **30%** of those taking the National CDM Credentialing Exam.
- Launched two, **45-hour comprehensive CDM, CFPP Advanced Practitioner courses**
- UND pass rates on the CDM Credentialing Exam **exceeds** the National Average.
