**Degree:** Bachelors of Business Administration with a Major in Management

**Purpose of degree:** The career you start right out of college likely won't be your last. The average American will have 12 to 15 different jobs over a lifetime. UND's Management degree is broad enough to give you the problem-solving and decision-making skills to handle whatever your career brings.

**Degree breakdown:** The Bachelors of Business Administration with a Major in Management at the University of North Dakota requires:

- 120 total credits
  - 30 credits must be taken at UND
  - 36 credits must be upper-division (300-level or higher)
- Essential Studies Requirements
  - Breath of Knowledge requirements waived (except those that are needed for the major requirements)
  - Special Emphasis requirements still needed
- Curriculum/Requirements for the Major in Management
  - 33 credits of Business Core Courses
  - 18 credits of Major Requirements
  - Earn a minimum GPA 2.00 (including transfer credits)
  - Earn a minimum UND GPA of 2.00
  - Earn a minimum GPA of 2.50 for all courses that apply towards the major (including transfer credits)
  - At least half of the business courses that apply towards the major must be from UND.
